WebTrak Basic Functions

Live and Replay Mode

Replay Mode

Tag a single flight

Check box for live mode (10 min. delay)

Click on a single aircraft for information

Click to register a complaint about a specific flight

Go from live to replay mode

Uncheck box to replay historical data

Specify date and time and click "Set"

Adjust speed of replay by sliding

Tag all flights

Click to get information on all displayed flights

Change map appearance

Click to change the appearance of the map

Display noise monitors

Click to view noise monitor locations and associated decibel levels for single events
