Fishermen's Terminal is going green and you can be part of the pollution solution! Here are quick ways you can reduce solid and hazardous waste and contribute to a cleaner environment.

Recycling Bins For Fishermen's Terminal moorage & storage tenants.

Gray Metal Recycling Bin - *NEW LOCATION* at West End of Net Shed 10

For all types of metal (ferrous and non-ferrous).

Please no fluids, such as crank case or anti-freeze.

Blue Mixed Recycling Bin - *NEW LOCATION* at West End of Net Shed 10

Paper and cardboard - clean paper, magazines, shredded paper, flattened cardboard.

Plastic - clean and rinsed plastic bottles, water, pop and milk containers, plastic dairy tubs.

Metal - clean and rinsed tin and aluminum cans.

Glass - clean and rinsed bottles and jars, (no lids).

Upland Tenant Recycle Containers Aluminum, paper, plastic & tin recycling bins are located at each of the commercial buildings. Call Rebecca Schwan 206-728-3713 if you need a key.

Cardboard Dumpster Located at the Terminal's south of Ship Supply building.

Fluorescent Tubes Please do not break or throw tubes into the dumpsters. Contact FT staff at 206-728-3395 or VHF 17 for disposal.
