

**NEW PARKING REGULATIONS
SHILSHOLE BAY MARINA
EFFECTIVE MARCH 10, 2009**

Management may establish reasonable traffic and parking regulations, including posting of signs and issuing of permits, as required for orderly handling of motor vehicles on Marina premises. Management may regulate and preserve the visual character for the Marina. Vehicles that visibly alter or are visually intrusive within the Shilshole Bay Marina setting will not be permitted.

Designated Parking Areas

A vehicle parked in violation of signs or regulations will be towed, impounded and will be released only after all charges and costs have been paid.

- Any vehicle in a “permit only” parking area without a visible and current year Shilshole Bay Marina parking permit will be towed.
- Public Parking areas (General Parking) are for the use of customers and persons involved with the use of Marina Facilities. There is not a charge or time limit for vehicles in Public/General Parking.
- Load/Unload designated areas are provided for the convenience of loading and unloading a vehicle and have a 15 minute time limit between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. Vehicles may park longer than 15 minutes after designated hours.

Usage not allowed in the marina parking lot

- Vehicles that are inoperable, unlicensed, have expired license tabs and/or are unable to be driven on the public roadways will be considered abandoned and will be towed.
- Vehicles used as storage and not for transportation.
- Storage of vehicles, boats, or other items or equipment. Customers who must leave their vehicle in the parking lot for any extended period of time while cruising (2 weeks or more) should register with the Marina Office.
- Vehicles displaying a “For Sale” sign unless displaying a current parking permit.
- Trailers, RV’s or other classified recreational vehicles are not allowed in the parking area. Vehicles over 22 ft. are allowed only in designated parking spaces or by special permission of Marina Management. Large tractor/trailer rigs and boat trailers are permitted for special events only with prior permission of Marina Management or in specifically designated spaces.
- Overnight camping is not permitted on Marina’s upland areas, parking lots, dry moorage areas, etc.
- Vehicles in the parking lot may not be used as a workshop or to conduct business transactions.

Disabled parking:

- Vehicles displaying a valid disabled parking permit may utilize any parking spot, except for fire lanes.

To ensure compliance with Marina Best Management Practices:

- Maintenance of vehicles in the parking lot is not allowed. Painting, engine or transmission removal is prohibited. Vehicles that leave significant amounts of fuel, oil, or transmission fluid in the parking lot are prohibited and may be towed at the owner's expense.
- No vehicle washing is allowed. All parking lot drains discharge into the marina waters. Please use a commercial car wash facility that recycles the contaminated water.

Safe traffic flow and access to buildings and docks:

- Vehicles must fit within the parking stall and cannot protrude into the roadway, on to the side walk or into a non designed parking area. No items may be stored under the vehicle.
- Vehicles may not park in front of gates, roll-up doors, doorways, driveways, or any place not specifically designed as a vehicle parking space.

Manage and control traffic, guest parking and space reserved for special events:

- Sponsored events held at the marina must be coordinated with the Marina office and must include an Event Agreement with the Marina and with specified parking arrangements.
- Event participants (where appropriate) will be given advance written instructions regarding parking arrangements and regulations by event coordinator.
- Signage regarding event parking or reserved space will be posted in advance by the Marina event coordinator.
- Marina staff will increase parking patrols during sponsored events to insure compliance with parking arrangements/regulations.
- Vehicles not in compliance with parking regulations will be towed at the owner's expense.
