



VESSEL INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

Minimum Insurance Requirements

As of October 1, 2009, a minimum of \$300,000 of General Liability insurance coverage (aka, Protection and Indemnity) is required for all vessels that fall into any one or more of the following categories:

1. Vessels with hull lengths greater than 16'.
2. Vessels with motors 10 horsepower or more.
3. Vessels that are in Dry Moorage and use our hoists to launch.

The following vessels types are **exempt** from the General Liability insurance requirement:

1. Human powered vessels of any size.
2. Dinghies/Tenders that are covered by the insurance policy of the vessel it tenders.
3. Muckleshoot and Suquamish Tribal Vessels.
4. Vessels in Dry Moorage that do not use the hoists to launch.
5. Guest moorage vessels staying less than 30 days.

Instructions for Providing Proof of Liability Insurance

1. Ensure you carry a minimum of \$300,000 of General Liability insurance (aka, Protection and Indemnity) for your vessel.
2. Contact and ask your insurance agent/company to add The Port of Seattle, Shilshole Bay Marina as a Certificate Holder or Interested Party to your policy.
3. Ensure your boat name and identification numbers (state registration or USCG documentation) is listed on the certificate
4. Also ask your insurance agent/company to send an electronic copy or hard copy to Shilshole Bay Marina office prior to October 1, 2009 (a valid insurance certificate must be active on October 1, 2009 and be maintained thereafter):
