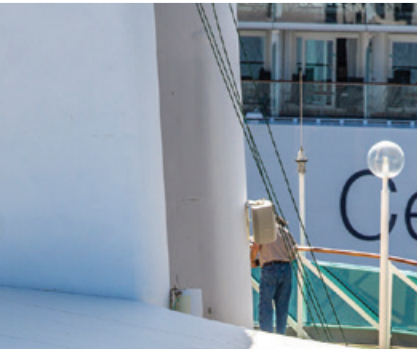

# EXPLORE

Your adventure begins in Seattle. It's a walkable city, surrounded by majestic mountains and flanked by Puget Sound. You can easily take in the city sights, take a ferry ride to a nearby island, or hike a rain forest.

Just minutes from your ship, discover the Seattle Aquarium and the Great Wheel soaring 175 feet in the air while enjoying breathtaking views of Mt. Rainier and the Olympic Mountains.

Or climb even higher, to the top of the Space Needle. At its base, you'll find the MoPOP Museum, a tribute to music history, science fiction and pop culture housed in the liquid architecture of Frank Gehry. Close by, Chihuly Garden and Glass, showcases glass blowing artist Dale Chihuly. Next, explore the flying fish at the famous Pike Place Market, or stop in at Starbucks' Reserve Roastery and Tasting Room.

If you've got an eye towards art and history, wander the Seattle Art Museum, the Olympic Sculpture Park, join the Underground Tour or soar at the Museum of Flight.

Up for a bigger adventure? Take a day trip and tour the Boeing airplane factory, hop a seaplane to the San Juans or enjoy the sun-soaked vineyards of the Yakima Valley.

## Bell Street Pier 66

You can't get much closer. Located along Seattle's bustling downtown waterfront, you're walking distance from the city's iconic landmarks, like the Pike Place Market, the Space Needle, Seattle Aquarium and the breathtaking Great Wheel. Bell Street is home port to Norwegian Cruise Line and Oceania Cruises.

## Smith Cove Pier 91

Smith Cove is home port to Carnival Cruise Line, Celebrity Cruises, Holland America Line, Princess Cruises and Royal Caribbean International. It's located at the north end of the waterfront—just 10-minutes away from the city's retail core. It serves two cruise ships at a time and is one of the world's only facilities where two ships can connect to the city's power grid, greatly reducing air emissions.
