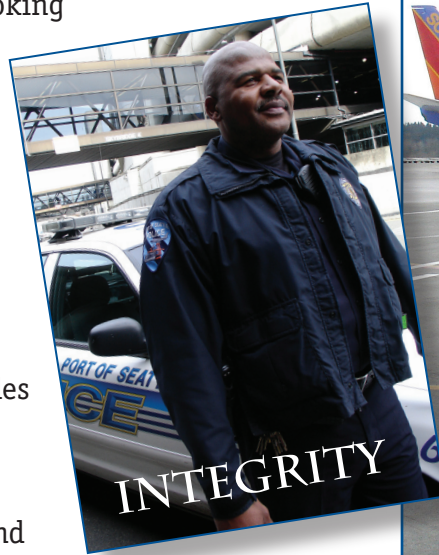


POLICING THE PORT

- ♥ Valid Washington State Driver's License
- ♥ Meet criminal and traffic history standards

- ♥ If hired, completion of Washington State Criminal Justice Training Academy or equivalent

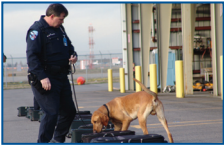
