	PB	Preferred brand: a slightly higher cost
	NP	Non-preferred brand: a higher cost
	PSP	Preferred specialty: lower cost for specialty drugs
	NPSP	Non-preferred specialty: higher cost for non-preferred specialty drugs
	CE	Copay Exception: Available to some members at no cost with a prescription from your provider when obtained at an in-network pharmacy. Certain limitations may apply.
