Women or minority business (WMBE)	Women or minority business (WMBE) is an umbrella term that includes MBE, WBE, and MWBEs
Minority Business Enterprise (MBE)	Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) means a business that is at least 51 percent (51%)owned and controlled by minority (including, but not limited to African Americans, Native Americans, Asians, and Hispanics) group members.
Woman Business Enterprise (WBE)	Women Business Enterprise (WBE) means a business that is at least 51 percent (51%) owned and controlled by women.
Minority Women Business Enterprise (MWBE)	Minority Women Business Enterprise (MWBE) is a business that is at least 51 percent (51%) owned and controlled minority women (including, but not limited to African Americans, Native Americans, Asians, and Hispanics) group members.
Combination Business Enterprise (CBE)	Combination Business Enterprise (CBE) is a business that is 51% owned and controlled by a combination of minorities or women that would not otherwise meet the definition of MBE, WBE, MWBE.
Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE)	Federally-Certified Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) is a certification provided by a Federal program designed for business owners deemed "socially and economically disadvantaged." To achieve DBE status, a business must be an existing "for-profit" business that is currently operational.
Airport Concessions Disadvantage Business Enterprise (ACDBE)	Federally-Certified Airport Concessions Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) is a certification provided by a Federal program designed for business owners deemed "socially and economically disadvantaged." To achieve DBE status, a business must be an existing "for-profit" business that is currently operational.
Small Business Enterprise (SBE)	Small Business Enterprise (SBE) means a business that meets the applicable size standards adopted by the U.S. Small Business Administration. An SBE may be either a Certified Small Business or a business that is self-declared to meet the applicable U.S. Small Business Administration size standard. Veteran Business Enterprise (VOB)	Veteran Business Enterprise (VOB) is a business that is at least 51% owned and controlled by a veteran or service member.
LGBTQ Business Enterprise (LGBTQBE)	LGBTQ Business Enterprise (LGBTQBE) is a business that is at least 51% owned and controlled by one or more individuals who identify as LGBTQ (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, or Queer).
