South King County Support Program Update

South King County Support Program Created

- On November 27, 2018 the Port of Seattle Commission created the South King County Support Program.
- From the adopted motion:
 - *“Within the funding plan for 2019-2023 there shall be funding, not to exceed \$10 million, designated for a South King County Support Program, which will be budgeted at \$750,000 in 2019, to be used to provide resources and support for Sea-Tac International Airport area communities.”*

South King County Support Program Development

- Commissioner and staff work is focused on:
 - Establishing a set of principles to guide Fund activity
 - Sample projects that could be implemented in a relatively short period of time
 - Ensuring equity through a comprehensive community engagement plan, and
 - Working to fashion an achievable timeline for both near-term and long-term activity

South King County Support Program Update

- Work continues on refining the guiding principles, with adoption at an upcoming Commission meeting
- Initial engagement efforts will begin in June 2019
- Commission actions necessary to implement short-term projects will take place after community engagement
