RESOLUTION NO. 3313

A RESOLUTION

of the port Commission of the Port of Seattle Declaring Certain Personal Property Surplus for Port District Purposes and further declaring that said property should be Sold or disposed of as provided by statute.

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle has owned the personal property described as Oshkosh T-3000 Truck #677, Serial No. 1QT9L5EH7D1020459, with equipment, estimated value at \$39,000; and

WHEREAS, said property is no longer needed for its intended purpose, or other purposes of the Port, and

WHEREAS, such property is not part of any comprehensive plan of improvement or modification thereof adopted by a vote of the people of said district; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Fire Service Training Academy, a division of the Washington State Patrol has publicized a need for surplus fire trucks. Port donation of the Oshkosh Crash Rescue Fire truck to the Academy at North Bend would respond to that need and subsequently benefit the Port in training of current, and future recruit firefighters, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 39.33 of the Revised Code of Washington provides that the Port may "sell, transfer, exchange, lease or otherwise dispose of any property...the state or any municipality or any political subdivision thereof...on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon...":

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle that the Oshkosh Truck #677, Serial No. 1QT9L5EH7D1020459, is no longer needed for district purposes and that it is in the best interest of said district that said property be donated to the Washington State Fire Service Training Academy, a division of the Washington State Patrol at North Bend, Washington; and

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle this <u>23rd</u> day of <u>February</u>, 1999, and duly authenticated in open session by the signature of the Commissioners voting in voting in favor thereof and the Seal of the Commission duly affixed.
