## **RESOLUTION NO. 3538**

**A RESOLUTION** of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle authorizing the Port of Seattle Police Department to dispose of unclaimed property in the evidence room.

WHEREAS, state law authorizes local law enforcement agencies to dispose of unclaimed property that comes into its possession in connection with its official duties; and,

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle Police Department (Department) desires to dispose of unclaimed property that comes into the Department's possession.

## **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle that:

- Section 1. The Port of Seattle Police Department is authorized to dispose of unclaimed property in the following manner:
- A. By public auction to the highest and best bidder
- B. Retain the property for the se of the Department after giving notice in the manner described in RCW 63 32.020 and following the recordkeeping requirements of RCW 63.32.010,
- C. Destruction, if the property has no substantial commercial value or the probable cost of sale exceeds the value of the property, the item is unclaimed after notice procedures have been met as prescribed in RCW 63.32.020, and the item is unsafe and unable to be made safe for use by any member of the general public.
- Section 2. Any proceeds from the sale of unclaimed property shall be used by the Port of Seattle Police Department for law enforcement purposes.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle this 5th day of May, 2005, and duly authenticated in open session by the signatures of the Commissioners voting in favor thereof and the seal of the commission.
