

RESOLUTION NO. 3558

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle
declaring the inventory property of the Radisson
Hotel located at 17001 Pacific Highway South surplus
and no longer needed for Port district purposes and
authorizing its sale by public auction.

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle (“Port”) owns certain personal property located at the
Radisson Hotel described below; and

WHEREAS, said property is no longer needed for its intended purpose, or other purposes
of the Port; and

WHEREAS, the Port desires to surplus said personal property and dispose of it pursuant
to Revised Code of Washington 53.08.090.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Port Commission of the Port of
Seattle, as follows:






Section 1: The following personal property from the Radisson Hotel is no longer needed
for Port purposes and it is the best interest of the Port that said property be declared surplus and
sold or disposed of:

Aviation Items	Estimated Resale Value
Vans, bedroom furniture, suite furniture, restaurant equipment, restaurant furnishings, pool supplies, laundry supplies, miscellaneous electronics and computer equipment.	\$160,000- \$180,000

Section 2: The Director, Accounting Procurement Services, is authorized to take all necessary steps to arrange for the sale of said property by public auction and to execute all documents necessary to accomplish its disposal in accordance with State law.

Section 3: Any acts of the Director, Accounting Procurement Services made consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this Resolution are hereby ratified and confirmed.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle at a regular meeting held this 24th of January, 2006, and duly authenticated in open session by the signatures of the Commissioners voting in favor thereof and the seal of the Commission.
