

RESOLUTION NO. 3562

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle declaring the Pier 2 railcar transfer span surplus and no longer needed for Port District purposes; and further authorizing its disposition through sale or disposal.

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle owns the railcar transfer span located at Pier 2;

and,

WHEREAS, said property is no longer needed for its intended purpose, or other purposes of the Port; and,

WHEREAS, the removal and disposal of said property is necessary to allow for the utilization of Pier 2 for other marine business activities; and,


WHEREAS, the Port now desires to surplus the Pier 2 railcar transfer span;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, as follows:


Section 1: The railcar transfer span at Pier 2 is no longer needed for Port purposes and is declared surplus to the Port's needs.


Section 2: Port staff is authorized to take all necessary actions to effectuate the sale or other disposition of said property.


ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle at a regular meeting held this 25th of April, 2006, and duly authenticated in open session by the signatures of the Commissioners voting in favor thereof and the seal of the Commission.
