Non-Federally Biometric Passenger Processing

Any proposed use of biometrics specifically in ways that is not required by the federal government. Example functions include bag check, ticketing, and access to the front of TSA security screening checkpoints.

Biometrics for Customer Functions

Examples of potential biometric (including facial) applications for customer functions could include:

- Access to facilities such as an airline lounge or the Port parking garage
- Access to a rental car at the Port's rental car facility;
- Use of biometrics for payment in lieu of credit card or cash; or
- Use of biometrics to inform dynamic signage targeting information or advertisements to travelers.
