

RESOLUTION NO. 3096, AS AMENDED

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle adopting the final budget of the Port of Seattle for the year 1992; making, determining and deciding the amount of taxes to be levied upon the current assessment roll; providing for payment of bond redemptions and interest, the cost of future harbor capital improvements and acquisitions, and for such general purposes allowed by law which the Port deems necessary; and directing the King County Council as to the specific sums to be levied on all of the assessed property of the Port of Seattle District in the year 1992.

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle Commission, on the 22th day of October, 1991, prepared the preliminary budget of the Port of Seattle for the year 1992 and provided for the publication of Notice of Final Budget Hearing on the adoption of said budget, to be heard on the 12th day of November, 1991, when taxpayers might appear and present objections to said preliminary budget, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on said preliminary budget was held in the office of the Port Commission, pursuant to notice duly given, in the City of Seattle, County of King, State of Washington, on the 12th day of November, 1991, at 1:00 p.m., and

WHEREAS, all parties present were afforded a full opportunity to present objections to the preliminary budget, and the Port Commission being duly advised in the premises.

WHEREAS, the King County Assessor has notified the Commissioners of the Port of Seattle that the assessed valuation of the property lying within the boundaries of said district for the year 1991 is estimated to be \$100,348,542,802.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle that the preliminary budget of the Port of Seattle for the year 1992, as modified and incorporated in the final budget for 1992, as presented at the aforementioned hearing, be and the same is hereby adopted as the final budget of the Port of Seattle for the year 1992.
