

**RESOLUTION NO. 3105**

**A RESOLUTION** of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle expressing recognition of and support for the purchase of the Seattle Mariners by a consortium of local interests headed by representatives of Nintendo of America.

**WHEREAS**, the Seattle Mariners are an important regional asset and a consortium of local civic leaders have come forward with a viable financial package to purchase the team;
