
A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, repealing Resolution No. 2749 which established a retirement policy tor regular employees.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2749, adopted by the Port Commission on October 31, 1978, established a policy of mandatory refirement ai age seventy (70) for regular monthly employees of the Port of Seattle who are paid on an hourly, per diem, or monthly salary basis; and

WHEREAS, since the adoption of Resolution No. 2749, Federal legislative changes, in effect, preclude a mandatory age for retirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Port of Seattle hereby repeals Resolution No. 2749.
