

RESOLUTION NO. 3011


A **RESOLUTION** of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, repealing Resolution **No. 2749** which established a retirement policy for regular employees.

**WHEREAS**, Resolution **No. 2749**, adopted by the Port Commission on October **31**, 1978, established a policy of mandatory retirement at age seventy **(70)** for regular monthly employees of the Port of Seattle who are paid **on an** hourly, per diem, or monthly salary basis; and

**WHEREAS**, since the adoption of Resolution **No. 2749**, Federal legislative changes, in effect, preclude a mandatory age **for** retirement.

**NOW**, THEREFORE, BE IT **RESOLVED** that the Port of Seattle hereby repeals Resolution No. **2749**.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle this 10<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1987, and duly authenticated in open session by the signatures of the Commissioners voting in favor thereof and the seal **of** the Commission.
