Port of Seattle in remembrance of Ivar Haglund

WHEREAS, Ivar Haglund, as part of the history of Seattle, came to symbolize the Seattle harbor and waterfront that he loved so much; and,

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle was enriched during Ivar Haglund's service as a Port Commissioner; and,


WHEREAS, Ivar Haglund contributed so much to the character of this community and to public recognition of the importance of Puget Sound and the harbor; and,
