

RESOLUTION NO. 2965

SECTION 1. The Port of Seattle does hereby amend and adopt rules and regulations shown in:


Sea-Tac International Airport Schedule of Rules and Regulations No. 4.

"PORT LIMITED-LICENSE TAXICAB" means a taxicab having executed an Airport Special Limited Taxicab Operating Agreement with the Port authorizing it to pick up and discharge customers or packages at the Airport on the Passenger Check-In Drive only, and only when its services are specifically requested by a customer; having paid all appropriate fees and charges therefor; and displaying a current Special Limited Taxicab permit decal issued by the Port.</p> <p>f. "NON PORT-LICENSED TAXICAB" means a taxicab failing to execute either an Airport Taxicab Operating Agreement or an Airport Special Limited Taxicab Operating Agreement with the Port, or failing to pay all appropriate fees and charges relating thereto, or failing to display an appropriate current taxicab permit decal issued by the Port.</p> <p>g. "CHARTER BUS" means a large motor coach that can carry many passengers. It is used to pick up and deliver passengers at the Airport that have been asked by a specific client or company to provide a charter bus service on a pre-arranged basis.</p> <p>14. "FIRE DEPARTMENT" means the Port of Seattle Fire Department unless otherwise referenced.</p> <p>15. "UNIFORM FIRE CODE" or "UFC" means the currently enforced edition of the Uniform Fire Code and as amended.</p> <p>16. "UNIFORM BUILDING CODE" or "UBC" means the currently enforced edition of the Uniform Building Code and as amended.</p> <p>17. "NATIONAL FIRE CODE" or "NFC" means the currently enforced edition of the National Fire Code and as amended.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>EXPLANATORY NOTES</u></p> <p>1.
