

RESOLUTION NO. 2846

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle requesting that the Executive Board of the Municipal Finance Officers Association (MFOA) of the United States and Canada select the City of Seattle as the site for its 1989 Annual MFOA Conference.

WHEREAS, the Pacific Northwest region has not hosted the annual conference of the Municipal Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada since 1961; and

Whereas, the Seattle/King County area will be able to suitably accommodate a meeting of such importance and size in 1989; and


WHEREAS, it is economically and politically important that a conference of local government financial leaders meet in the Pacific Northwest; and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington will celebrate its 100th anniversary of statehood in 1989 and will be especially attractive for tourism; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Finance Officers Association has a policy of holding its annual conference in a variety of suitable locations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the undersigned Commissioners, on behalf of the Port of Seattle, request the Executive Board of the Municipal Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada to select the City of Seattle as the site for its 1989 Annual Conference.
