

RESOLUTION NO. 2662

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle declaring certain personal property surplus for Port District purposes and further declaring that said property should be disposed of as provided by statute.


WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle has owned personal property located at the Port of Seattle's Pier 30 in the form of a vehicle loading ramp more particularly shown and described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and


WHEREAS, due to modifications in the operation of the Port and changes in the needs and requirements of the Port, said property is neither used nor needed for its intended purpose or other purposes of the Port; and


WHEREAS, such property is not part of any comprehensive plan of improvement or modification thereof, adopted by the vote of the people of said district:


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Seattle that the property shown and described in Exhibit "A" (Port of Seattle Drawing No. 30-6300-S-5) attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein is no longer needed for district purposes, and that it is in the best interests of said district that said property be declared surplus and sold or disposed of as provided by statute.
