

RESOLUTION NO. 2745

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle declaring personal property surplus for Port District purposes and further declaring that said property should be sold or disposed of as provided by statute.

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle owns the personal property described below; and


WHEREAS, said property is neither used nor needed for its intended purpose or other purposes of the Port; and

WHEREAS, such property is not part of any comprehensive plan of improvement or modification thereof, adopted by the vote of the people of said district;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Port of Seattle Commission that the property described below is no longer needed for Port district purposes, and that it is in the best interests of said district that said property be declared surplus and sold or disposed of as provided by statute:

1. One (1) 1971 Nashua Mobile Home, Serial No. EYB2KD-657, located at Parcel Z-201, Park Lane Manor, Space No. 33.
2. One (1) 1958 Whiting Trackmobile. (Rail car mover)
