BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, as
follows:

SECTION 1. The Port of Seattle does hereby establish and adopt
rules, regulations, and charges shown in:



copies of which are hereby annexed and made a part of this Resolution, said
rules, regulations, and charges to take effect on the dates thereon.

SECTION 2. All rules, regulations, and charges conflicting with
the provisions of the above-listed pages in Port of Seattle Schedule of
Rules, Regulations, and Charges No. 2 Applying at Fishermens' Terminal and
Shilshole Bay Marina are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That the Traffic Manager be and is hereby directed to
file said schedules with the Federal Maritime Commission.

<p>MOORAGE FOR FISHING VESSELS AND PLEASURE CRAFT INCLUDES ONLY USE OF MOORING SPACE ALONGSIDE OF FLOAT AND ACCESS FOR SUSTENANCE AND SUPPLIES OVER THE PIER FOR THE VESSEL PAYING MOORAGE CHARGES.</p>	<p>1100 MOORAGE DEFINED</p>
<p><u>GUEST REGISTRATION</u></p> <p>ALL GUEST BOATS REMAINING FOR A PERIOD OF FOUR (4) HOURS OR MORE, WHETHER MOORED OR ANCHORED, MUST BE REGISTERED BY OWNERS OR OPERATORS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AFTER ARRIVAL AT THE REGISTRATION BOX NEAR THE MARINA OFFICE. GUEST BOATS WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE DAILY MOORAGE CHARGES NAMED IN ITEM <u>1160</u>. ALL MOORAGE CHARGES MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO THE DEPARTURE OF THE VESSEL FROM THE MARINA.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> ALL BOATS ENTERING MARINA MUST HAVE AN INDIVIDUAL AND IDENTIFYING NAME OR NUMBER PERMANENTLY AFFIXED TO BOAT AND VISIBLE FROM THE OUTSIDE. IF REQUIRED BY FEDERAL OR STATE LAW, NAME OR NUMBER MUST BE VALID. FAILURE TO HAVE EITHER MAY BE CAUSE FOR REFUSAL OF MOORAGE.</p> <p>A PENALTY CHARGE OF \$3.00, IN ADDITION TO GUEST MOORAGE CHARGE, WILL BE ASSESSED VESSELS NOT REGISTERED ON THE DAY OF ARRIVAL. IN THE EVENT MOORAGE CHARGES ARE NOT PAID PRIOR TO THE DEPARTURE OF THE VESSEL FROM THE MARINA, A PENALTY CHARGE OF \$3.00, IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER CHARGES, WILL BE ASSESSED TO COVER COLLECTION CHARGES.</p> <p>A TIME LIMIT FOR MOORAGE AT THE GUEST DOCK <u>MAY</u> BE ESTABLISHED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT TO MEET OPERATIONAL NEEDS. A VESSEL WHICH REMAINS AFTER THE ESTABLISHED TIME LIMIT WILL BE ASSESSED TWICE THE DAILY GUEST MOORAGE CHARGE FOR THE REMAINDER OF ITS STAY.</p> <p>A VESSEL WHICH REMAINS AT THE MARINA GUEST DOCK AND IS UNREGISTERED FOR A PERIOD LONGER THAN ONE DAY <u>MAY</u> BE IMPOUNDED PENDING SETTLEMENT OF ALL CHARGES. A VESSEL WHICH MOORS AT SHILSHOLE BAY MARINA, THE OWNER OF WHICH IS INDEBTED TO THE PORT FOR PREVIOUS MOORAGE, MAY BE IMPOUNDED IMMEDIATELY.</p> <p>A VESSEL REQUESTING A RESERVATION FOR SPACE IN A GUEST AREA MUST COMPLETE AN ADVANCE REGISTRATION AND PAY A \$4.00 FEE, WHICH IS IN ADDITION TO REGULAR MOORAGE CHARGES, WHICH BECOMES DUE UPON ARRIVAL. THIS FEE IS NOT REFUNDABLE UNLESS RESERVATION IS CANCELLED AT LEAST THREE (3) HOURS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL TIME. SPACE SO RESERVED WILL NOT BE HELD FOR LONGER THAN THREE (3) HOURS AFTER SCHEDULED ARRIVAL TIME.</p> <p><u>LONG TERM REGISTRATION</u></p> <p>LONG TERM REGISTRATION IS SUBJECT TO SPACE AVAILABILITY AND EXECUTION OF THE MOORAGE AGREEMENT SHOWN IN ITEM <u>1140</u> BETWEEN VESSEL OWNER AND PORT OF SEATTLE. RULES, RATES AND CHARGES PERTAINING TO THE USE OF PORT OF SEATTLE PROPERTY AND FACILITIES AT SHILSHOLE BAY MARINA BY THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

ITEM NO.

ELECTRIC SERVICE RATES:

ONE AND ONE-HALF CENTS (1-1/2¢) PER KILOWATT-HOUR DELIVERED AT DOCKSIDE TO ANY VESSEL, WITH MINIMUM CHARGE OF \$1.00 PER MONTH, IF MORE THAN 25 KWH OF ELECTRICITY ARE USED AT ANY TIME DURING BILLING PERIOD. BILLING PERIOD WILL NOT EXCEED THREE (3) MONTHS.

FOR GUEST BOATS USING ELECTRICITY, THERE WILL BE A CHARGE OF ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) PER DAY WITH A MAXIMUM CHARGE OF \$15.00 PER MONTH WHEN CONNECTED TO A 20-AMP OUTLET AND \$20.00 PER MONTH WHEN CONNECTED TO A 30-AMP OUTLET, UNLESS METER IS AVAILABLE, IN WHICH CASE METER READINGS WILL BE USED WITH A MINIMUM OF \$1.00 PER MONTH.

SERVICE VOLTAGE:

THE NORMAL SERVICE TO A VESSEL WILL BE 120 VOLT, 3 WIRE, 60 CYCLES PER SECOND ALTERNATING CURRENT WITH A CAPACITY OF 20 AMPERES CONTINUOUS. ONE SIDE OF THE SERVICE CIRCUIT WILL BE GROUNDED.

SERVICE AT 120 VOLTS, SINGLE THREE-WIRE, 30-AMPERE CAPACITY, MAY BE MADE AVAILABLE TO ANY VESSEL AT ANY ONE BERTH FOR A SERVICE CHARGE OF \$20.00 PAID IN ADVANCE AND NON-REFUNDABLE.

SERVICE

METERING:

THE PORT OF SEATTLE SHALL INSTALL, OWN AND MAINTAIN SUITABLE ELECTRIC SERVICE METERS ADJUSTED TO REGISTER WITHIN ONE (1) PERCENT OF THE CORRECT VALUE.

IF ANY METERING SHOULD BECOME DEFECTIVE, UPON CORRECTING SAID DEFECT PORT OF SEATTLE SHALL ADJUST AND CORRECT THE BILLINGS FOR THE PRECEDING THREE-MONTH PERIOD ONLY, TO WITHIN ONE (1) PERCENT OF THE CORRECT VALUE.

UPON REQUEST AND PAYMENT OF A \$10.00 METER TESTING CHARGE IN ADVANCE, THE PORT OF SEATTLE WILL TEST AND RENDER A CERTIFICATE OF TEST FOR ANY VESSEL ELECTRIC SERVICE METER. IF THE METER TESTED IS FOUND WITH ERROR IN EXCESS OF ONE (1) PERCENT OF THE TRUE VALUE OF ENERGY (AT 120 VOLTS, 15 AMPERES, 90 PERCENT POWER FACTOR), THE \$10.00 METER TESTING FEE WILL BE REFUNDED.

CONTINUITY OF SERVICE:

THE PORT OF SEATTLE SPECIFICALLY DOES NOT GUARANTEE: CONTINUITY OF ELECTRIC SERVICE TO ANY VESSEL, THE CHARACTERISTICS OF ANY SERVICE THAT IS PROVIDED, OR THE CHARACTERISTICS OF THE VESSEL SERVICE CIRCUIT BREAKER.

SERVICE AND UTILIZATION EQUIPMENT ON BOARD VESSELS:

ALL SERVICE CONNECTIONS BETWEEN THE PORT OF SEATTLE OUTLETS AND THE VESSEL, AND ALL UTILIZATION EQUIPMENT UPON THE VESSEL SHALL CONFORM WITH THE CITY OF SEATTLE ELECTRICAL CODE AND/OR THE STATE OF WASHINGTON ELECTRICAL CODE.

CHANGE OF ELECTRICAL OUTLET:

EACH BERTH IS PROVIDED WITH EITHER A 20-AMP OR 30-AMP OUTLET AND CIRCUIT BREAKER. IF OUTLET AND BREAKER ARE CHANGED AT REQUEST OF TENANT, A LABOR CHARGE OF \$15.00 WILL BE MADE TO CUSTOMER.

MOORAGE FOR FISHING AND COMMERCIAL BOATS UNDER SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

ITEM NO.

MOORAGE FOR FISHING AND COMMERCIAL VESSELS AS PROVIDED FOR IN THIS ITEM APPLIES ONLY WHEN SUCH VESSELS ARE MOORED IN AREAS AND LOCATIONS DESIGNATED FOR SUCH USE BY SIGNS LABELED COMMERCIAL VESSEL. FOR MOORAGE IN OTHER AREAS SEE ITEMS 1110 AND 1160.

MOORAGE:

DAILY: FISHING AND COMMERCIAL VESSELS PROCEEDING TO AND FROM FISHING AREAS OR WAITING FOR PASSAGE THROUGH THE GOVERNMENT LOCKS ARE PERMITTED 24 HOURS FREE MOORAGE.

PER VESSEL: 10¢ PER FOOT OF REGISTERED LENGTH, EXCEPT DURING SEASON WHEN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON HAS AUTHORIZED AREA 6 OPEN FOR COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHING, THEN 5¢ PER FOOT. MINIMUM CHARGE: \$1.00. TO BE ENTITLED TO THIS LATTER RATE, VESSEL MUST ACTUALLY BE ENGAGED IN FISHING, I.E., ENGAGING IN SALMON FISHING AT LEAST 50 PERCENT OF DAYS FISHING IS SO AUTHORIZED BY THE STATE.

MONTHLY: FISHING VESSELS ONLY DURING SEASON WHEN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON HAS AUTHORIZED THAT AREA 6 IN PUGET SOUND IS OPEN FOR COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHING AND ONLY WHEN ACTUALLY ENGAGED IN FISHING. AT OTHER TIMES, VESSEL MUST FISH AT LEAST TWO DAYS PER WEEK.

PER VESSEL: GILLNET - SAME AS AT FISHERMENS' TERMINAL
PURSE SEINER - SEE ITEM 1070

PAYMENT OF THIS MONTHLY RATE WILL ENTITLE VESSEL TO MOOR AT EITHER FISHERMENS' TERMINAL OR SHILSHOLE.

FISHING AND COMMERCIAL VESSEL REGISTRATION AND PROCEDURES:

1. ALL FISHING AND COMMERCIAL VESSELS REMAINING FOR A PERIOD OF MORE THAN 24 HOURS, WHETHER MOORED OR ANCHORED, MUST BE REGISTERED BY OWNER OR OPERATORS, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AFTER ARRIVAL, AT THE REGISTRATION BOX NEAR THE MARINA OFFICE. VESSELS WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE CHARGES OUTLINED IN ITEM 1155 DURING COMMERCIAL FISHING SEASON AND ITEM 1160 AT OTHER TIMES.
2. ALL MOORAGE CHARGES MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO DEPARTURE OF THE VESSEL FROM THE MARINA. VESSEL OWNERS OR OPERATORS WILL NOT BE BILLED FOR CHARGES UNLESS THEY HAVE, PRIOR TO ARRIVAL OR DEPARTURE, ESTABLISHED A CUSTOMER CREDIT RELATIONSHIP SATISFACTORY TO THE PORT AND SUPERINTENDENT OF SHILSHOLE BAY MARINA. A VESSEL OWNER OR OPERATOR WHO HAS NOT BEEN APPROVED FOR CREDIT AND WHO DOES NOT PAY MOORAGE PRIOR TO DEPARTURE WILL BE CHARGED \$3.00, IN ADDITION TO MOORAGE, AS A BILLING CHARGE.
