Before and During Snow Events

#### SLOW DOWN!

- Bagwell Entrances
- Reduced Visibility
- Slick Surfaces
- Markings Obscured
- Reduced Towed Weight



#### Stay Safe

##### Personal Protective Equipment

- Seatbelt
- ANSI-2 reflective vest
- Hearing protection
- Eye protection
- Gloves
- Warm Jacket under reflective vest
- Proper foot wear/boots
- Job specific PPE
- Cloth face covering

### SNOW REMOVAL

- Lift with your legs, not your back
- Keep feet apart
- Keep shovel level & close to body





## Check Your Gear/Equip

### Prior to Use

Driver is responsible for pre-use check

- ✓ Tactile check of connections
- ✓ Seatbelt working & not frayed
- ✓ Pintle hook connection secure
- ✓ Hitch-pin spring in tact & unfrozen
- ✓ Brakes working
- ✓ Lights/turn signals
- ✓ Tire/wheel condition
- ✓ Chocks applied
