

RESOLUTION NO. 2545

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle

BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle,
as follows:

SECTION 1. The Port of Seattle does hereby establish and
adopt rules, regulations, and charges shown in:



2-F, F.M.C.-T No. 3, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That the Traffic Manager be and is hereby directed
to file said schedules with the Federal Maritime Commission.

TERMINAL STORAGE - SPACE RENTAL

WHEN IN THE OPINION OF THE TERMINAL OPERATOR, SPACE FOR SUCH PURPOSE IS AVAIL- ABLE AND SUCH USE THEREOF WILL NOT INTERFERE WITH THE STORAGE OF CARGO UNDER OTHER PROVISIONS OF THIS TARIFF, AREAS OF COVERED STORAGE SPACE MAY BE RESERVED FOR THE STORAGE OF CARGO FOR PERIODS OF NOT LESS THAN 30 DAYS. THE CHARGE FOR SUCH STORAGE SHALL BE TWO AND ONE-HALF CENTS (2-1/2¢) PER SQUARE FOOT PER MONTH, PAYABLE IN ADVANCE, SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS AND NOTE (A) NO SPACE WILL BE RENTED, THE GROSS AREA OF WHICH IS LESS THAN 1,000 SQUARE FEET. (B) ALL NECESSARY SERVICES REQUIRED OR REQUESTED IN CONNECTION WITH CARGO STORED UNDER THIS ITEM WILL BE PERFORMED BY THE TERMINAL OPERATOR UNDER RATES, RULES AND REGULATIONS SPECIFIED IN THIS TARIFF. (C) STORAGE PROVISIONS APPLY ONLY ON CARGO PRIOR TO OR SUBSEQUENT TO MOVE- MENT OVER A PORT OF SEATTLE MARINE TERMINAL AND CARRIAGE BY VESSELS. (D) NO CANCELLATION OF RENTAL AGREEMENTS ENTERED INTO UNDER THIS ITEM WILL BE PERMITTED ON LESS THAN 15 DAYS NOTICE. A FULL MONTH'S CHARGE WILL BE MADE FOR THE MONTH IN WHICH THE AGREEMENT IS CAN- CELLED OR THE AREA VACATED. NOTE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ITEM WILL NOT BE GRANTED IN TRANSIT SHEDS WHEN SUCH FACILITY IS ACTIVELY BEING USED TO LOAD AND DISCHARGE VESSELS.	60150
