

Portable Containers Best Management Practices

Portable containers must be properly managed and stored to prevent pollutants from entering stormwater drains. When managing portable containers, the following Best Management Practices (BMPs) must be followed:

- Store containers in a structure or under cover
- Store materials in a leak-proof container with tight fitting lid
- Label all containers with contents/hazards or as empty
- Address leaking containers immediately transfer contents to another container or place on secondary containment
- If safe to do so, clean up leaks/spills with absorbent materials immediately
 - Pick up absorbents after use!
- Train employees on proper housekeeping and storage practices
- Document BMPs and keep training records



- Not covered
- Materials stacked haphazardly
- Containers not stored upright

- Covered storage
- Elevated off ground
- Secondary containment (on left)
