

## RESOLUTION NO. 21.

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle providing for the publication of notice of special election to be held March 5, 1912, and designating the papers in which such publication shall be made.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle as follows.

That publication of the notice of special election to be held in said Port District on the 5th day of March, 1912, be made in the following daily newspapers of general circulation in said Port District;

That said notice be published in each and every issue of the Seattle Post Intelligencer during a period of at least twenty (20) days prior to said election.

And that such notice be also published in at least three issues of the Seattle Star, during said period of twenty (20) days preceding said election.

Adopted by the Commissioners of the Port of Seattle this 9th day of February, 1912, and signed by its proper officers in authentication of its passage on the same date.
