



Enhanced Customer Experience Benefits


- Faster access to gates and facility for passengers on arriving flights, connection times drop from 90 to 75 minutes
- Simpler, more secure "bags first" arrival process reduces passenger stress
- Expansive interior eliminates crowding, allows for faster processing of more guests

Economic Development

- SEA is a gateway for continued economic development in the region
- SEA Airport accounted for \$3.6 billion in direct earnings and \$22.5 billion in business revenue in 2021
- The airport generated 151,400 jobs, including 87,300 direct jobs making it one of the country's largest job centers
- In (pre-pandemic) 2019, SEA was the eighth busiest airport in the U.S.





This project is designed to achieve LEED V4 (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design, Version 4) Silver certification.






