## RESOLUTION NO. 36

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commisaion of the Port of Seattla, providing for the condemnation of land and other property for the purpose of croating, maintaining and operating the Salmon Bay Improvement, being a part of unit Ill. 3 of the comprehensive scheme of harbor improvement in the port district of the Port of Scattie, as adopted by the Port Commission on Fobruary 7 , 1912, and ratified by the people of the port district at a special election held on Karch 5, 1912.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, as follors:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of creating, man ntaining and operating, by lease or directiy, a harbor improvement in the port district of the Port of Sesttle, known as the Salmon Bay Improvement, being a part of unit No. 3 of the comprehensive scheme of harbor improvement, officially adopted by the commissioners of said Port of Seattle by resolution, in meeting duly assembled on the seventh dey of February, 1912, and submitted to the people of said port district and by them ratified at a special election called for that purpose, held throughout said port district on the fifth day of March, 1912, and for the construction, maintenance and operation, by lease or directly, thereon of a quay and combination warehouse and storehouse adapted to and equipped for freight and passenger handling, with the necessary dredging and railroad connection thereto, a car ferry landing with railroad conneotions, a coal bunker, a wharf, landing atages, marine railway, an oil tank with pipes and connections, an overhead bridge for street connection, together with the equipment, appurtenances and appliances of phatever sort or kind necessary or convenient for the fall, complete and economical accomplishment of such maintenance and operation, the lande and property hereinafter described are
necessary, to-wit:
