

RESOLUTION NO. 88

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle accepting the award made in the case of Port of Seattle vs. the Oregon & Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, et al, in the Superior Court of the state of Washington for King County.

WHEREAS, on the 29th day of January, 1913, judgment was entered in cause No. 87995, entitled Port of Seattle vs. Oregon & Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, et al, for the condemnation of certain portions of block three and block five, and a portion of vacated Propsect Street, all in Seattle Tide Lands, and a portion of Reserve "A" in Gilman's Addition to the city of Seattle, embracing in all 36.2215 acres, more or less; and

WHEREAS said judgment provided an award for said property in the sum of \$250,000.00; and

WHEREAS, under the law, said Port Commission has sixty days from the date of said judgment in which to accept or reject said award;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PORT COMMISSION OF THE PORT OF SEATTLE, as follows:

Section 1. That said award in said cause of Port of Seattle vs. Oregon & Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, et al, of two hundred and fifty thousand dollars for the land taken, be and the same is hereby accepted.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle in open session this 6th day of February, 1913, and signed by its proper officers in open session in authentication of its passage on the same date.
