

## RESOLUTION NO.103

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle setting the time for a public hearing on the question of making certain changes in and additions to the comprehensive scheme of harbor improvement heretofore adopted.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PORT COMMISSION OF THE PORT OF SEATTLE,

as follows:

SECTION 1. That the port commission hereby designates Wednesday, May 7, 1913, at two o'clock P.M., as the time, and the office of the port commission, 843 Central Building, Seattle, Washington, as the place for holding a public hearing upon the proposed changes of and additions to the comprehensive scheme of harbor improvement heretofore adopted by the port commission and ratified by the vote of the people in the port district.

SEC. 2. That the secretary is hereby directed to give notice of said public hearing in the manner provided by statute.

ADOPTED by the port commission of the port of Seattle in open session this 17th day of April, 1913, and signed by its proper officers in open session in authentication of its passage, on the same day.
