

RESOLUTION NO. 120.....

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle providing for the calling for bids for the furnishing of lumber handling machinery for the Smith's Cove Improvement.

WHEREAS, plans and specifications for the construction of what is known as the Smith's Cove Improvement of the Port of Seattle have been prepared, which plans and specifications have been approved by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle by Resolution No. 102, dated April 16th, 1913;

AND WHEREAS, said Port Commission is desirous at the present time of securing bids for the furnishing of lumber handling machinery as provided in said plans and specifications,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PORT COMMISSION OF THE PORT OF SEATTLE, as follows:

Section 1. That the Secretary of the Commission shall and he is hereby authorized and directed to give such notice as is required by law, inviting sealed proposals for furnishing of said lumber handling machinery, bids to be opened on the 17th day of July, 1913 at 1:30 o'clock P. M.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle on this 14th day of June, 1913, and signed in open session by its proper officers in authentication of its passage on the same day.
