## A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, Washington, adopting certain amendments and additions to Unit No. 18 of its Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvement.

WHEREAS, the original Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvement of the Port of Seattle (hereinafter called the "Port") was fixed in Resolution No 17 of the Port Commission and ratified by the qualified electors of the port district at a special election held therein on March 5, 1912, and

WHEREAS, Unit No. 18 of the Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvement was heretofore adopted by the Port Commission of the Port by Resolution No. 1194 and ratified by the qualified electors of the port district at a special election held therein on November 5, 1946, which unst has been subsequently amended in the manner provided by law; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 14, 1969 after notice of such hearing was duly given as provided by law, on the question of whether or not said Unit No. 18 should be further amended and added to, to permit the Port to acquire certan property adjacent to such dirport, and to dispose of other properties found to be surplus and no longer required for airport purposes, and

WHEREAS, a fter discussion and consideration of said proposed amendments, additions, deletions and improvements to the Seattle-Tacoma International Airpart (Unit No. 18) at said hearing, the Commission has decided that said unit should be further amended and
added to as hereinatter provided,
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Port
Commission of the Port of Seattle, Washington, as follows:
Section 1 That after and pursuant to a public hearing held on October 14, 1969, following notice thereof given as required by law, the Port Commission of the Port does hereby adopt the following amendments and additions to Unit No. 18 (Seattle-Tacoma International Airport) of its Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvement as fixed by Resolution No 1194 of the Port Commission and ratified by the qualified electors of the port district at a special election held therein on November 5. 1946, and as later amended in the manner required by law, the Port is authorized
(1) To acquire the following described land area for purposes of aprons, air cargo, roadways, highway access, and other airport improvements. (Shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

The west half of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 28, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W M., King County, Washington, EXCEPT the east 13000 feet thereof and EXCEPT the south 3000 feet thereof, said area contains approximately 124,606 square feet.
(2) To delete and dispose of the following land areas no longer needed for airuort purposes (Shown on Fxhibit "A" attached hereto.)
(a) That portion of the WI/2 of the SE1/4 of the NW1/4 of the SE1/4 of Section 28, Twp. 23 N . Range 4 E , W. M., King County, Washington containing approximately 28,287 square feet described as follows

Beginning at the intersection of the west line of the E1/2 of the SE1/4 of the NW1/4 of the SEl/4 of said section with the south line of the N1/2 of the SE1/4 of sald section, proceed N 430 -33'-21'W, 41.53 feet, thence $\mathrm{N} 33^{\circ}-20^{\prime}-51^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}, 273.20$ feet to the true point of beginning, thence northwesterly and northerly along the arc of a curve to the right, with a radius of 770.76 feet, a distance of 274.65 feet, thence $N 2^{-}-43^{\prime}-21^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}, 72.28$ feet to a point which is 3100 feet south of the south margin of South 170th Street; thence S $88^{\circ}-59^{\prime}-10^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, parallel to said south margin, 12334 feet, thence $S 1^{\circ}-26$ $39^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}, 6295$ feet to a point of curvature; thence southerl/ and southwesterly along the arc of a curve to the right, with a radius of 36800 feet, a distance of 96.34 feet to a point of tangency, thence $S 16^{\circ}$ -$26^{\prime}-39^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}, 5.61$ feet to a point of curvature, thence southwesterly and southerly along the arc of a curve to the left, with a radius of 432.00 feet, a distance of 16420 feet, thence $S 66^{\circ}-51^{\prime}-39^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, 27.02 feet to the true point of beginning. All bearings are lambert.
(b) That portion of the W1/2 of the SE1/4 of the NW1/4 of the SEl/ 4 of Section 28 , Twp. 23 N , Range 4 E , W. M., Kıng County, Washington containing approximately 43,931 square feet described as follows

Beginming at the intersection of the west line of the E1/2 of the SE1/4 of the NW1/4 of the SE1/4 of sand section with the south line of the N1/2 of the SEl/4 of sald section, proceed N $1^{\circ}-29^{\prime}-36^{\prime \prime}$ E along said west line, 5677 feet to true point of beginning, thence continuing along said west line, 55062 feet to a point 16. 00 feet south of the south margin of South 170 th Street, thence N $88^{\circ}-59^{\prime}-10^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$, parallel to South 170th Street, 7653 feet, thence S $1^{\circ}-26^{\prime}-39^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$. 7839 feet to point of curvature; thence southerly and southwesterly along the arc of a curve to the right, with a radius of 42700 feet, and distance of 11179 fect to a point of tangency, thence $S 16^{\circ}$. 26'-39' W, 561 feet to a point of curvature, thence southwesterly and southeasterly along the arc of a curve to the left, with a radius of 373.00 feel a distance of 38419 feet to true point of beginning. All bearings are lambert
(c) That portion of the NE1/4 of the SWl/4 of the SE1/4 of Section 28, Twp. 23N, Range 4E, W M., King County, Washington containing approximately 13,202 square feet described as follows.

Beginning at the intersection of the west line of the E1/2 of the SE1/4 of the NW1/4 of the SE1/4 of said section with the south line of the Nl/2 of the SE1/4 of said section, proceed $S$ 3 $8^{\circ}-7^{\prime}-53^{\prime \prime}$ E along said south line, 6958 feet and true point of beginning. thence continuing along said south line, 29154 feet. thence S $l^{\circ}-38^{\prime}-27^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}, 5858$ feet, thence $\mathrm{N} 88^{\circ}$. 33'-21' W, 9262 feet, thence westerly and northwesterly along the arc of a curve to the right with radius of 373.0 feet, a distance of 20957 feet to true point of beginning. All bearings are lambert.

The areas to be acquired and to be disposed of are more particularly shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein All of the above set forth additions, alterations, betterments and improvements shall be all as more fully set forth in the Comprehensive Scheme, Unit No 18 (Seattle-Tacoma International Airport) now on file at the main office of the Port located at the Bell Street Terminal in Seattle, Washington

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle at a regular meeting thereof held this 25 th day of November, 1969, and duly authenticated in open session by the signatures of the Commissioners voting in favor thereof and the seal of the Commission

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
