RESOLUTION NO 2325

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle renewing a delegation of authority to the General Manager to Dispose of Surplus Property.

WHEREAS the Port Commission has from time to time delegated to its General Manager certain authority for purposes of expeditious administration of the Port, including the right to sell certain surplus property, and

WHEREAS Revised Code of Washington 53, 08, 090 requires this delegation to be renewed annually and authorize this administrative authority of the General Manager,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle that the General Manager is authorized and directed to exercise the authority herein defined. The General Manager may

- Dispose of surplus personal property of the Port of Seattle subject to the following conditions
 - a. That the value of such personal property does not exceed \$2,500.00,
 - b That such property is actually surplus to
 the Port's operational requirements, including
 (1) personal property acquired incidental to
 real property acquisitions, (2) building and
 construction materials remaining after completion of authorized construction and maintenance projects, and (3) property acquired pursuant
 to valid lien executions or abandoned on Port
 premises;
 - c. That offers for purchase are solicited from

at least three (3) parties,

- d. That complete records of such disposals are kept and summarized monthly and reported to the Port Commission, and
- e. That in no case shall surplus personal property be sold to any Port official or employee or members of their families.

This resolution reaffirms the provisions set forth in Resolution No. 2289 as adopted by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle on February 25, 1969

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle this 24th day of March, 1970, and duly authenticated in open session by the signatures of the Commissioners voting in its favor and the seal of the Commission.
