

RESOLUTION NO. 2364

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle
modifying certain rates, rules, and regulations
in Seattle Container Freight Station Tariff No. 1,
F.M.C.-T No. 5.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle, as
follows:

SECTION 1. The Port of Seattle does hereby establish and adopt
rules, regulations, and charges shown in:

Seattle Container Freight Station Tariff No. 1, F.M.C.-T No. 5
2nd Revised Page No. 3, Item 30
2nd Revised Page No. 5, Item 120,

copies of which are hereby annexed and made a part of this Resolution, said
rules, regulations, and charges to take effect on the dates thereon.

SECTION 2. All rules, regulations, and charges conflicting with
the provisions of the above listed pages in Seattle Container Freight Station
Tariff No. 1, F.M.C.-T No. 5, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That the Traffic Manager be and is hereby directed to
file said schedules with the Federal Maritime Commission.

F. AN ASSIGNMENT SHALL NOT BE TRANSFERRED OR SUBLET BY ASSIGNEE. VIOLATION OF THIS RULE WILL SUBJECT THE ASSIGNEE TO IMMEDIATE CANCELLATION OF THE ASSIGNMENT.

G. ANY RATES, CHARGES AND CONDITIONS, INCLUDING CHANGES AND ADDITIONS THERETO, THAT ARE APPLIED BY THE ASSIGNEE FOR THE CONDUCT OF CFS ACTIVITIES SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE GENERAL MANAGER OF THE PORT OF SEATTLE.

THE RATES HEREIN CONTAINED ARE ASSESSED PER SQUARE FOOT (SQ. FT.) PER MONTH OR FRACTION THEREOF AND PER 100 LBS. OF CARGO IN ACCORDANCE WITH NOTES 1, 2, 3, AND 4.

NOTE 1 CHARGES AND BILLING WILL COVER THROUGH THE LAST DAY OF EACH CALENDAR MONTH. WHEN RATE IS ASSESSED PER SQ. FT. THE MINIMUM CHARGE SHALL BE FOR ONE MONTH AND WHICH SHALL APPLY TO A FRACTIONAL BEGINNING OR TERMINATION MONTH.

NOTE 2 THE RATES INCLUDE NOMINAL WATER, LIGHTING AND ELECTRICITY.

NOTE 3 RATE INCLUDES NOMINAL CLERICAL OFFICE SPACE AND NOMINAL AUTO PARKING SPACE FOR CFS STAFF. AT TERMINAL 102 THE RATE INCLUDES USE OF RAIL SIDING AT BUILDING 16-17 FOR WORKING RAIL CARS.

NOTE 4 AT MAIN CFS BUILDING, TERMINAL 102, THE RATE INCLUDES OPEN PAVED AREA EXTENDING TO 65 FEET FROM CFS DOORS AND AT OTHER ASSIGNED LOCATIONS SUFFICIENT AREAS ADJOINING DOORS AND PLATFORMS FOR THE POSITIONING OF TRAILERS AND TRUCKS FOR LOADING AND UNLOADING.

H. THE ASSIGNEE SHALL MAINTAIN RECORDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH GENERALLY ACCEPTED ACCOUNTING PRACTICES AND SHALL REPORT ONCE EACH MONTH ON FORMS PROVIDED TO REFLECT TRAFFIC HANDLED AND OTHER INFORMATION AS MAY BE REQUIRED FOR SETTLEMENT OF ASSIGNMENT CHARGES. THE PORT OF SEATTLE OR ITS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT AT ANY REASONABLE TIME TO INSPECT ALL RECORDS AND ACCOUNTS OF THE ASSIGNEE TO VERIFY SETTLEMENT TRANSACTION BETWEEN THE PORT AND ASSIGNEE.
