

RESOLUTION NO. 2410


A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle
repealing Resolution No. 367

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle Commission by Resolution No. 367
resolved to deposit fill material just outside the Outer Harbor Line,

WHEREAS, the deposition of fill material into the waters of the State
of Washington is contrary to the intent and policy of the Washington
"Environmental Policy Act of 1971,"

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Port Commission of the
Port of Seattle, Washington that Resolution 367 is repealed.

meeting thereof held this 8th day of February, 1972, and duly authen-
ticated in open session by the signatures of the Commissioners voting in favor
thereof and the Seal of the Commission duly affixed.
