SECTION 2. All rules, regulations, and charges conflicting with he provisions of the above listed Items in Seattle Terminals Tariff No. 2-E, NN.I. No. 24, F.M.C.-T No. 1, and Seattle Terminals Tariff No. 100-A, NN.T. No. 25, F.M.C.-T No. 2, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That the Traffic Manager has been directed to file and schedules with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission and the Federal Maritime Commission.
