

TARIFF AMENDMENT DIRECTIVE NO. 41

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Resolution No. 2072 of the Port of Seattle Commission, dated the 13th day of December 1960, the undersigned does hereby find that it is necessary, in order to maintain the Port's terminal rate structure at a compensatory level, and to maintain equitable free time arrangements, for the Port of Seattle to, and the Port does hereby, establish and adopt as schedule and tariff rates, charges, rules, and regulations for terminal services, the rates, rules and regulations as named in:

Items 10935, 10936, and 10937, Original Page 29-A, Seattle Terminals Tariff No. 2-E, copies of which are hereby annexed and made a part of this directive; said rates, rules, and regulations to take effect on the date shown on above mentioned tariff page.

SECTION 2. That the Traffic Manager be and is hereby directed to file said tariff schedule of rates with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission and Federal Maritime Commission.
