A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle prescribing wharfage, storage, and other charges for service for use of wharves, floats, net rooms, net racks, marine ways, and other facilities offered at the Salmon Bay Improvement.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PORT COMMISSION OF THE PORT OF SEATTLE, as follows:

Section 1. That the following motoring charges for boats lying along floats and wharves at the Salmon Bay Improvement shall be in effect from and after October 1, 1913, and such charges shall include, and shall be in lieu of, all wharfage for discharging fish catches or loading supplies for fishing vessels:

Sec. 2. That, for the net-room and net rack, not exceeding 15 x 20 feet floor space, where tenant is also paying mooring charge for at least one boat, the rental shall be \$3.00 per month. For similar space where tenant is not paying mooring charge the rate shall be \$5.00 per month. These rates do not include the use of the marine ways.

Sec. 3. That the following charges be made for the use of marine ways during the first 24 hours, one-half the rates prescribed in this schedule to be collected for each day or fraction thereof after said first 24 hours:

Sec. 4. That the rent charge for storage of boats on skids, racks, or dry land shall be at the same rates prescribed in Section 1 herein for mooring along floats and wharves.

Sec. 5. That all rentals, for whatever period, shall be paid in advance.

Sec. 6. It shall be the duty of the Dock Master in charge to make all collections prescribed in this resolution, delivering his signed receipt therefor, a carbon copy of which shall be retained and delivered to the Auditor of the Port.

Sec. 7. This resolution is amendatory of Resolution No.37 so far as it conflicts therewith, and the Commission reserves the right further to amend in any particular without notice.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle this 25th day of September, 1913, and signed in open session by its proper officers in authentication of its passage on the same date.
