

RESOLUTION NO.151

A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle adopting certain plans and specifications for, and providing for the calling of bids for the construction of a Section of the East Waterway Terminal Improvement, Project No. 2.

WHEREAS, plans and specifications for the construction of the wharf, substructure, slope and slope revetment, of what is known as Section No.1 of the East Waterway Terminal Improvement, Project No. 2 of the Port of Seattle, have been duly prepared, which plans and specifications are identified by the appropriate title and the signature of the Secretary and of the Port Commission of October 2, 1913; and

WHEREAS, said Port Commission is desirous at the present time of securing bids for doing the work involved in said plans and specifications,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PORT COMMISSION OF THE PORT OF SEATTLE, as follows:

Section 1. That said plans and specifications be and the same are hereby adopted.

Sec. 2. That the Secretary of the Commission be and he is hereby authorized and directed to give such notice as is required by law, inviting sealed proposals for the construction of said Section No.1 of the East Waterway Terminal Improvement, Project No.2, upon said plans and specifications and upon alternative plans and specifications of the bidder accompanying his bid, bids to be opened on the 3rd day of November, 1913, at 1:30 P.M.

ADOPTED by the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle this 2nd day of October, 1913, and signed by its proper officers in open session on the same day in authentication of its passage.
