A RESOLUTION of the Port Commission of the Port of Seattle authorizing filing of application with the Economic Development Administration, U. S. Department of Commerce, United States of America, for a grant and/or loan under the terms of Public Law 89-136.

WHEREAS, under the terms of Public Law 89-136, the United States of America has authorized the making of grants and/or loans to public bodies and private or public non-profit organizations or associations to aid in financing the construction of specific public projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Port of Seattle Commission:

1. That Robert W. Norquist, President of the Port of Seattle Commission, be and he is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the Port of Seattle with the Economic Development Administration, U. S. Department of Commerce for a grant and/or loan to aid in financing the construction of 2570 lineal feet of berth and bulkhead and additional fill at the Pier 18 Container Terminal. This terminal will enable the Port to accommodate the newly expanding container service in the Foreign Trade.
