Page 22A, Schedule of Ground Transportation Services Violation Fines and Other

Fees, effective February 1, 2023

#### **BACKGROUND**

Aviation Operations manages and regulates all commercial Ground Transportation providers at Seattle-Tacoma International Airport. Ground Transportation violation fines are included within each Operating Agreement to:

- 1) Support overall enforcement of the operating agreement;
- 2) Impose a financial penalty that will serve as a deterrent to prohibited activities and operating agreement infractions
- 3) Encourage company accountability for individual driver behavior and discourage any unacceptable behavior.

Aviation Operations proposes dollar amount changes and removal of duplications, to the Schedule of Ground Transportation Violation Fines as outlined in the table below. These changes reflect the types of infractions that are being committed by commercial Ground Transportation operators.
