



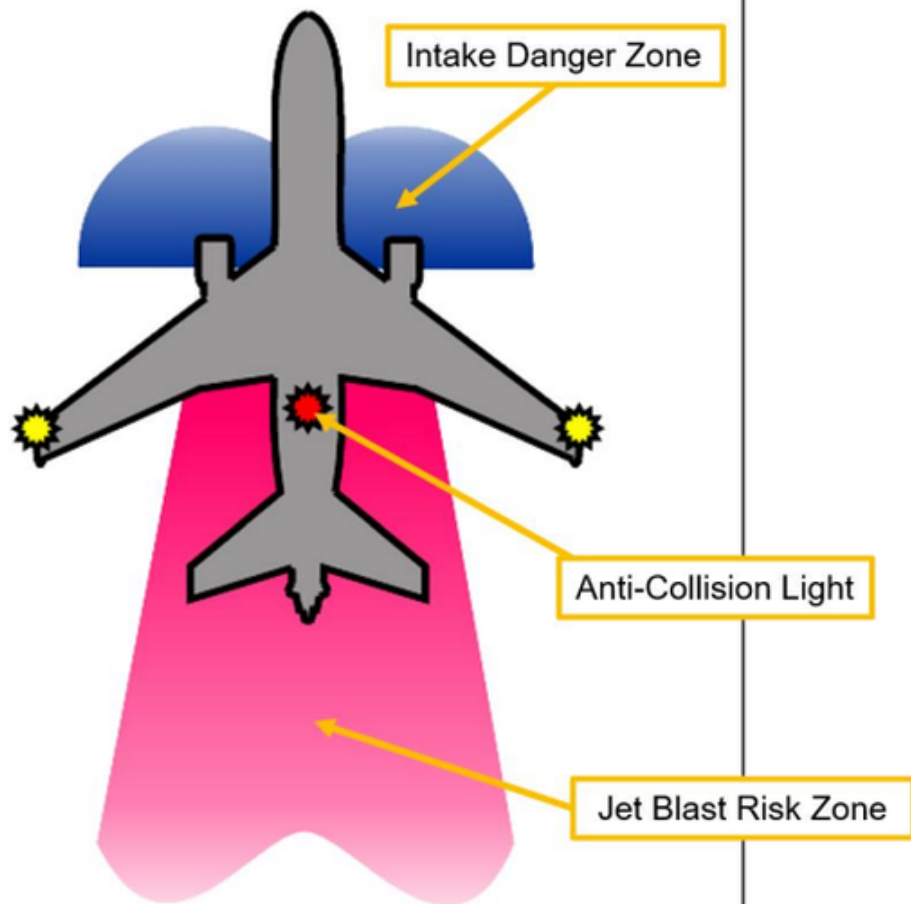
Safety Reminder

Preventing Engine Ingestion Injuries

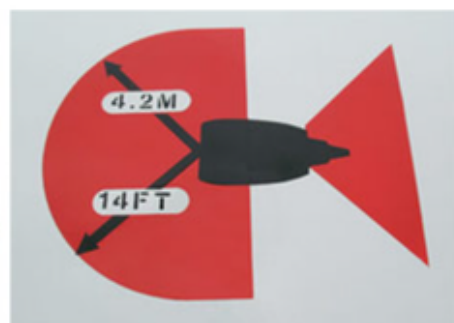
ALL RAMP PERSONNEL WHO WORK NEAR AIRPLANES NEED TO KNOW THE LOCATIONS OF ENGINE INLET HAZARD ZONES.

Because of the dangerous pull of engine suction, it is important for ground personnel working near commercial airliners with operating engines to stay at a safe distance from the engine area to avoid the possibility of injury or death.

ENGINE DANGER ZONES



Never approach or walk or drive behind an aircraft until the anti-collision lights have been turned off, the engines run down and the chocks are in place
