Diversity in Contracting Policy Directive

Purpose:

Advance equity and address contracting disparities by increasing the utilization of Women and Minority Business Enterprises, and other disadvantaged firms.

Five-year Policy Benchmarks: (this is our 5th year)

- ☐ Increase to 15% the amount of spend on WMBE contracts within 5 years (Baseline was 5.3%)
- ☐ Triple the number of WMBE firms doing business with the Port (Baseline was 118; Goal is 354)




Replace a total of four (4) 400Hz rotary motor-generators and seven (7) gate boxes that are nearing end of functional lifespan.





Current State and Location




Current State and Location

- Replace generators in place with weatherproof casing
- Utilize indoor space near Gate D1 and build a room for D Concourse generators and associated equipment.

Improvements would include the following components/systems

- Architectural
- Fire Suppression
- Mechanical/HVAC
- Power (Medium Voltage)
- Storm Drainage
- Structural/Seismic

Other components/systems address by other capital projects (communications, lighting, low voltage power, revenue control, vertical circulation)

Completion of safety and operational improvements on Air Cargo Rd between S 168th St and S 154th St


Project Overview:
