- Checkpoint 1 Relocation Project Impacts Gina Marie Lindsey Hall baggage
 claim barricades are pushing out in for build-out of new passenger screening
 checkpoint. Movement will be rerouted for SmarteCarte restocking, and
 employee access to Port of Seattle's office and South Employee Screening.
 Impacts are expected until November.
- SEA Underground Controls Replacement Project Impacts Construction
 activity ongoing in South Loop SEA Underground Tunnel 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 Monday to Thursday. Closure of A Station and Yellow Line with extended shuttle
 mode from B to S Stations only. Complete closure of SEA Underground South
 Loop Monday to Tuesday from 11:59 p.m. to 2:30 a.m. with
 over-the-ramp-bussing from Gates B20 to S1A.
- SEA Gateway Project Impacts Baggage Claim 14-15 small restrooms (both men and women's) are closed and expected to reopen April 19.
- Planewear Reopens Now in the Central Terminal, Planewear has reopened with daily open hours from 5:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
