### Airport News (June 13 - 20)

- **Checkpoint Construction** - TSA Checkpoint 3 is scheduled to re-open at 4 a.m. on June 14 and assume 24/7 operational hours with SEA Visitor Pass, SEA Spot Saver, General, and Premium Screening lanes.
- **Restroom Closure** - The D3 restrooms will be closed from June 18 - 21 for flooring work. The closest alternatives are the **D1 restrooms** or the **D5/D6 restrooms**.
- **New Children's Play Area in the D Annex** - The construction is complete for the new Children's Play Area near D25.
- **Passport Online Applications Open** - The U.S. Department of State has reopened its pilot program to allow Americans to renew passports online! As of today, a limited number of applications will open daily at 1 p.m. Eastern time on a first-come, first-served basis.
- **United Baggage Service Office Open** - The United BSO (Baggage Service Office) is now open near baggage claim 9.
- **Daily Flights to Taipei are Underway on Delta Air Lines** - SEA Airport welcomed Delta Air Lines' first nonstop flight to Taipei from the U.S. Ahead of a potentially record-breaking summer, passengers now have even more options for direct access to international destinations as a record 51 services take flight from SEA.
