






Aviation Spend and Utilization

CHIRRP - Concourse HVAC Infrastructure Renewal and Replacement Project

In addition to the AHU Renewal/Replacement, the following work will be completed in all three alternatives:

- Ceiling Replacement
- Lighting Renewal (sustainability
 less energy plus controls)
- Add Smoke Control
- AHU Programming
- Replace Pneumatic Controls
- Replace fire sprinkler heads as require by code.
- Renew /replace utilities (ductwork, piping)




1947 Watermain Improvements




Estimated Cost: \$8-10 M

RFP Issue: **Q4 2025**

Federal Funding / DBE

- Replacement of 16" DI watermain
- Pavement remediation/ surface restoration
- Roadway improvements (illumination, signage, etc.)

Widen Arrivals Bus Canopy



Estimated Cost: \$2-3 M RFP Issue: Q1-Q2 2025

- ~300 LF Canopy for north Rental Car Transit Curb
- Canopy structure, sidewalk, lighting, communications
- Incorporates public art but not in contract (glass canopy, seating)

T18 Pile Cap Repairs




