### Airport News (March 19 - 26)

- **Air Tahiti Nui Special Family and Friends Fare** - For employees traveling from Seattle to Tahiti, the fare is \$700 (inclusive of taxes and fees) in Economy and is valid for travel from January through December 2025. The booking period ends at the end of the month.
- **South Employee Screening Closures Continue** - The closures of South Employee Screening and the hallway leading to the AOB elevators on baggage level has been extended through March 21, it will be closed from 4 p.m. to 2 a.m. Employees will be redirected to **North Employee Screening** during these times.

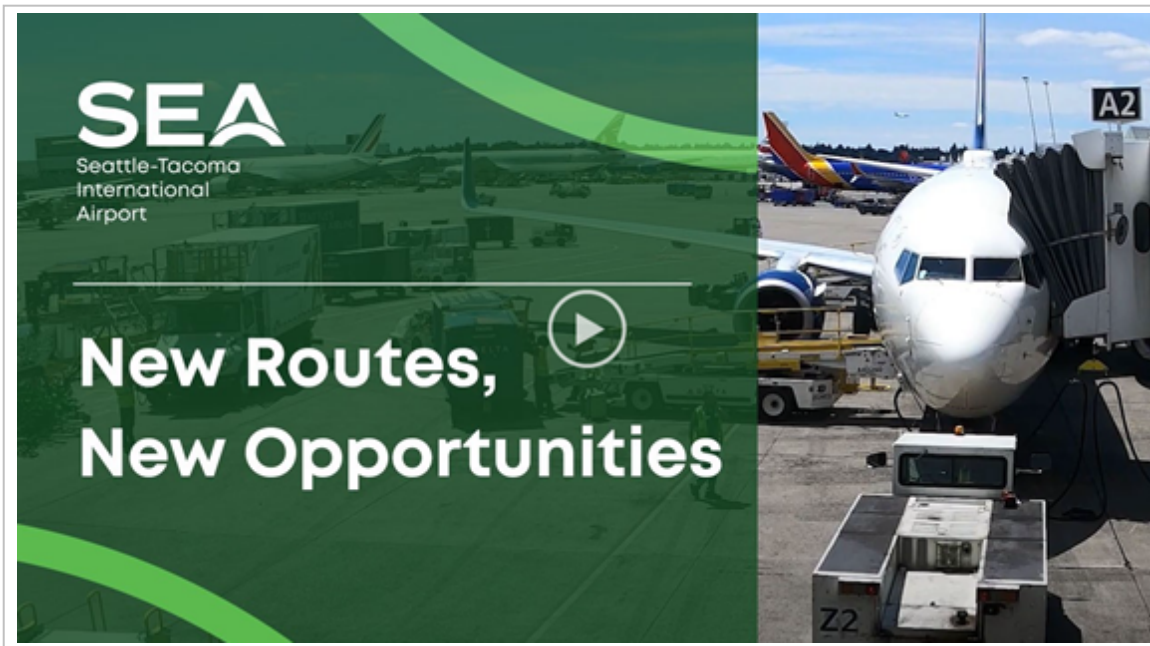
- **SEA Underground Upgrades**
  - Overnight work for the SEA Underground Trains will have station closures and limited stops. Shuttle mode will continue to take place with bussing at B20/21 from March 17 - 20.
- **Roadway Improvements (Widen Arrivals Roadway)**
  - This project will perform trenching across all lanes of the expressway resulting in intermittent lane closures after the split to Arrivals/Departures between 10 p.m. and 8 a.m. from March 24 - 28.

This work should take 4 nights.

- **Maintenance**
  - From March 26 - 27, there will be AIP work needing to perform some overnight fuel shutdowns at several N gates.
