## Airport News

### April 16 - 23

- Checkpoint Renumbering REMINDER All checkpoints (currently 1-5) will be renumbered overnight April 16. The new numbers will be active Thursday, April 17 at 4 a.m. and will be labeled as Checkpoints 1-6. Here's a rundown of what the checkpoints will be starting <u>April 17:</u>
  - **Checkpoint 1** OPENING SOON
  - **Checkpoint 2** TSA PreCheck, CLEAR
  - Checkpoint 3 General Screening, CLEAR, Premium, SEA Spot Saver

- Checkpoint 4 General Screening, CLEAR, Premium, SEA Spot Saver, SEA Visitor Pass
- Checkpoint 5 TSA PreCheck, CLEAR
- Checkpoint 6 CLOSED FOR CONSTRUCTION

Here's what's happening with Upgrade SEA. **The Interactive Map is available** with the latest information

- SEA Underground Controls
  - Full shutdowns of the south loop (A/B/S stops) for 5 nights of bussing April 27- May 1 and May 4 - May 8 (11 p.m. - 2 a.m. and 4 a.m. - 5 a.m.).

#### SEA Gateway

- On April 21 the installation of Terrazzo flooring along the Esplanade, spanning the area between Checkpoints 5 and 6. This work will take place directly in front of Checkpoint 5 screening lanes 4 and 5.
- On April 16 the arrivals door 8 will open and Arrivals door 16 will close for renovation.
- C16 restrooms will close one at a time between 10 p.m. and 4:30
  a.m. on April 14 -18. Signage will direct travelers to C3 restrooms.
- Maintenance
  - Seattle Made closes down with barricades going up April 16, demo and then build out for Hudson Non-Stop begins April 21

- Closure of Men's/Women's/Family Restrooms, Baggage Level, Gina Marie Lindsey Hall between 10 p.m. - 4 a.m. Monday -Thursday nights (weekly through May 16)
- News Stand in N gates is closing April 17th and will be barricaded for renovation. The space will be turned into Emerald City Market.



Starting Thursday, April 17, 2025, at 4 a.m., all checkpoints will be renumbered 1-6 (formerly 1-5). The reason for this is to make way for a brand-new checkpoint opening soon that will be the new TSA Security Checkpoint 1 down on the Baggage Claim Level. This will mean that the current Checkpoint 1 that services TSA Precheck and CLEAR passengers on the far south end of the Ticketing Level will switch to Checkpoint 2, and then the numbers will continue up as you go north on the Ticketing Level.
